Coggins Information:

- All horses must go through Coggins Inspection Area located at the east gate of the SIRAS Grounds
- You must have a PAPER copy of the Negative Coggins when the horse arrives for inspection.
- Coggins must be dated 2018
- Coggins Screening Times:
 - Friday from 2pm until 8pm
 - Saturday & Sunday from 7am until Noon
 - Outside of this time, you must make an appointment with Penny 204 467-8789 Or 204
 795-8213 to enter the grounds
- Decision of the Coggins inspector is final
- Horses will not be permitted on the property without a valid Negative Coggins No Exception

Registration Forms:

- Completed entry forms, waivers & payment can be
 - o mailed to the address on the entry form
 - o emailed to stonewallhorseshow@gmail.com along with EMT (electronic money transfer)
 - o dropped off at the North 9 Tack Sale on Sunday May 13th 2018
 - Must be received by (not postmarked by) the show Secretary by May 25th in order to qualify for the reduced office fee of \$10
- Post-dated cheques will not be accepted. Registration forms received without payment or waivers will not be processed.
- You must use horse's registered name on the entry form for NISC or NAERIC points
- No Refunds on show day. No exceptions.
- The show will proceed rain or shine unless determined to be unsafe by the judge or SIRAS representative. No rain date, no refunds.
- Age categories are as of January 1st of this current year. Lead line 8 & under, Pee Wee 10 & under, Junior 13 & under, Intermediate 14 18, Senior 19 & over.
- Please contact the show secretary as soon as you know you have changes to make do not wait until the day before or the day of the show. It is a lot of work to make changes, please get the changes to us ASAP

** NEW ** Show Times:

- Competitor numbers can be picked up Friday from 6pm-9pm at the Red Barn (during supper)
- Show Office opens at 7 a.m. at the announcer's booth both Saturday and Sunday
- Show starts at 9am sharp Saturday and Sunday
- There is a \$4.00 gate fee per person entering the grounds. Competitors will be provided with a complimentary wristband

Stabling:

- 40 box stalls are available for \$10 each day to the first 40 paid entries/requests
 - o Friday 6pm to Saturday 6pm \$10 Stall Fee
 - Saturday 6pm to Sunday 6pm \$10 Stall Fee
- Stalls are only for horses registered in the show
- Tack stalls NOT available.
- You must clean out your stall prior to leaving the grounds
- Temporary pens not permitted; competitors may tie to their trailers.

Show Rules & Class Explanations:

- All Peewee classes are walk/trot only. Loping will be penalized per incident.
- Training aids such as draw reins, side reins, training forks, martingales & hackamore's are not permitted.
- Halter classes are judged on the horse; showmanship classes are judged on the handler and presentation
- A horse may only be ridden twice per class and only once per age division
- Basic Western Pleasure Class #13 is walk/trot only. No cross entry with any Loping classes
- Basic English Pleasure Class #28 is walk/trot only. No cross entry with any Loping classes
- Rookie reining pattern for 2018 is NISC pattern #1. Will be posted at show.
- Rookie reining rule allows for the use of 2 hands and switching hands during reining class.
- The show reserves the right to change the order of go, cancel or combine classes
- It is mandatory for all participants registered in Peewee, Junior and Intermediate classes to wear a correctly fitting CSA approved riding helmet.
- All participants under 16 years of age must be accompanied by a parent, guardian or coach, who
 must remain on the grounds at all times.
- Horses found not sound or riders/horses considered unsafe will be excused by the judge or the appointed SIRAS representative.
- During a timed or judged event in the ring, the judge's decision is final. Outside of the show ring, decisions made by the SIRAS representatives are final.

- Concerns should be directed to the SIRAS representative(s) immediately. Every effort will be made to mitigate the problem.
- NO STALLIONS, no exceptions.
- All dogs must be on leash.
- Any direct confrontation or use of inappropriate language with the judge or show committee members will result in the following:
 - Loss in prize money and points
 - Eviction from show ring/grounds for the rest of the show and perhaps future years.
- The SIRAS and/or any person connected with, or officiating at this show are not responsible for any loss, damage or injury resulting from participation in this show or related events.
- This show is an N.I.S.C. (North Interlake Show Circuit) and NAERIC sanctioned event
- Timed Games Explanations :
 - SIRAS Cup Shuffle is cups being placed on poles (no dismounting required)
 - Speed Ball is dropping a golf ball into a pylon
 - o 6 Legged race is an in-hand class with no riding or saddle required
